Nagarjuna's Precious Garland

Monday, June 30th through Friday, July 25th

For Summer Course 2014 <u>Ganden Jangtse Choje Rinpoche</u> (Gyume Khensur Lobsang Tenzin) will give teachings on **Nagarjuna's** <u>Precious Garland</u> based on the commentary by Gyaltsab Dharma Rinchen.

"The <u>Precious Garland</u> is one of the classic texts of Indian Buddhism. Written by Nagarjuna in the 2nd century (C.E.) as advice to a powerful king, the text weaves together the themes of spiritual liberation and worldly power that is profound but accessible. Nagarjuna counsels the king on ... virtuous activities ... from providing ... hospitals, pure drinking water, and religious centers, to the best ways to overcome greed, lust and ignorance. ... Nagarjuna brings home the crucial insights of dependent arising and emptiness. ... The careful reader will come away transformed, strong evidence that the work has lost none of its relevance." **
